



These terms and conditions apply to the schools and football clubs entering the prize draw.

1. The Promoter

The promoter is: Football Association of Wales Limited ("**FAW**") of The Pavilion, Vale Resort, Hensol, Vale of Glamorgan, CF72 8JY.

2. How to enter

- 2.1 The prize draw will run from [00:00] on [06/11/23] (the "**Opening Date**") to [23:59] on [14/11/23] (the "**Closing Date**") inclusive.
- 2.2 All prize draw entries must be received by the FAW in accordance with condition 2.3 by no later than [23:59] on the Closing Date. All prize draw entries received after the Closing Date are automatically disqualified.
- 2.3 To enter the prize draw, the school or football club must submit their group booking form by the Closing Date.
- 2.4 To redeem the prize, entrants must have bought group tickets for and attended the Cymru U21 v Iceland U21 (16/11/23) or Cymru U21 v Denmark U21 (20/11/23) match.
- 2.5 The FAW will **not** accept:
 - (a) responsibility for prize draw entries that are lost, mislaid, damaged or delayed in transit, regardless of cause, including, for example, as a result of any postal failure, equipment failure, technical malfunction, systems, satellite, network, server, computer hardware or software failure of any kind; or
 - (b) transmission as proof of receipt of entry to the prize draw.
- 2.6 By submitting a prize draw entry, the school or football club is agreeing it will be bound by these terms and conditions.

3. Eligibility

- 3.1 The prize draw is only open to local schools and football clubs who have made a group booking for the above fixtures in the UK, **except**:
 - (a) employees of the FAW or its holding or subsidiary companies;



- (b) employees of agents or suppliers of the FAW or its holding or subsidiary companies, who are professionally connected with the prize draw or its administration; or
- (c) members of the immediate families or households of (a) and (b) above.

- 3.2 In entering the prize draw, the school or football club is confirming that it is eligible to do so and eligible to claim the prize.
- 3.3 There is a limit of one entry to the prize draw per school or football club (age group). Multiple age groups in the same football club for instance are allowed to enter once per age group.
- 3.4 The FAW reserves all rights to disqualify an entry submitted by a school or football club if their conduct is contrary to the spirit or intention of the prize.
- 3.5 Prize draw entries cannot be returned.

4. The prize

- 4.1 The first prize is the opportunity to win a ball signed by the Cymru U21 team, the second prize is the opportunity to attend a Cymru U21 training session and the third prize is the opportunity to win mascot places to walk out with Cymru U21 before a home match.
- 4.2 Prizes are subject to availability. There is no cash alternative for the prize. The FAW has the right to change, alter or withdraw the prize draw or the prize at any time due to any change in any applicable law or any events outside the control of the FAW.
- 4.3 The prize is not negotiable or transferable.
- 4.4 In order to claim the prize you must look out for an email from the FAW and accept the prize within 48 hours of receiving it.

5. Winners

- 5.1 The winners will be selected at random on [15/11/23]. The decision of the FAW is final and no correspondence or discussion will be entered into.
- 5.2 The FAW will notify the school or football club of the winners personally as soon as practicable after the date referred to in condition 5.1, using the telephone number or email address provided with the prize draw entry.



5.3 The FAW must either publish or make available information that indicates that a valid award took place. To comply with this obligation the FAW may send the name of the school or football club of prize winners to anyone who emails [tickets@faw.cymru] or writes to the address set out in Condition 1 (enclosing a self-addressed envelope) within one month after the Closing Date of the prize draw.

5.4 If you object to any or all of your football club name or school name and winning entry being made available, please contact the FAW. In such circumstances, the FAW must still provide the information and winning entry to the Advertising Standards Authority on request.

6. Claiming the prize

6.1 If you are the winner of the prize, you will have 48 hours from the time at which the FAW notifies the winning school or football club to claim the prize by verbally accepting the prize. If you do not claim the prize by this date, your claim will become invalid.

6.2 The prize may not be claimed by a third party on your behalf.

6.3 The FAW will make all reasonable efforts to contact the winning school or football club. If they cannot be contacted or is not available, or has not claimed the prize within 48 hours of the FAW's notification, the FAW reserves the right to offer the prize to the next eligible entrant selected from the entries that were received before the Closing Date.

6.4 The FAW does not accept any responsibility if you are not able to take up the prize.

7. Limitation of liability

Insofar as is permitted by law, the FAW, its agents or distributors will not in any circumstances be responsible or liable to compensate the winner or accept any liability for any loss, damage, personal injury or death occurring as a result of taking up the prize except where it is caused by the negligence of the FAW, its agents or distributors or that of their employees. Your statutory rights are not affected.

8. Data protection and publicity

8.1 The FAW will only process your personal information as set out in the [<https://faw.cymru/privacy-policy/>]. See also condition 5.3 and condition 5.4, with regard to the announcement of winners.



9. General

- 9.1 If there is any reason to believe that there has been a breach of these terms and conditions, the FAW may, at its sole discretion, reserve the right to exclude you from participating in the prize draw.
- 9.2 The FAW reserves the right to hold void, suspend, cancel, or amend the prize draw where it becomes necessary to do so.
- 9.3 These terms and conditions shall be governed by English law, and the parties submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of England and Wales.
